**Description of the work:**

The lead partner Aids-Hilfe Potsdam as a branch organisation of the German AIDS-Help is a major stakeholder in the field community care and support for the PLHIV. It draws on interdisciplinary expertise in counselling, care and referral for medical treatment in HIV-specialised clinics/practices. A medical expert (HIV-treatment physician) will be subcontracted via competitive tender for the purpose of compiling the results of the stock-taking survey on treatment and referral and management of HIV Co-infections.
